TRAVEL INFORMATION

The Hidden Gardens is located through Tramway at 25 Albert Drive and is easily accessible with public transport.



Train: The Hidden Gardens is only 5 minutes by train from Glasgow Central (operated by [ScotRail](#)).

Trains to [Pollokshields East station](#) run around every 15 minutes. Once at Pollokshields East, go up the stairs, turn right, and continue on until you reach Tramway.

Bus: There are many buses which go near The Hidden Gardens. From the City Centre, the 3, 38 and 57 (operated by [First Glasgow](#)) take you to Pollokshaws Road. There is a [bus stop opposite Albert Drive](#). First buses 4, 5 and 6 (operated by [First Glasgow](#)) go along Victoria Road. Get off the bus at [Eglinton Toll](#), walk down Pollokshaws Road to Albert Drive.
