

## Bird feeder and bird bath to make

You will need 2 plastic bottles (a milk, water or juice bottle is great), ready meal or take away food tray, scissors, old pencils or dowels, permanent marker pens or stickers to decorate.



Wash the bottles and food trays well.  
In one bottle cut circular openings (get an adult help with this) as shown in the picture

(get an adult to help with this bit) Make holes in the bottle using the picture as a reference, cut the pencils or dowels to length so that when you push the pencils in it leaves enough sticking out for the birds to perch on them.



Cut a rectangle from the second bottle or a ready meal food tray to fit over the pencils at the bottom of the bottle. (See picture) this is where you will put the food for the birds.



Decorate the feeder with permanent marker pens or stickers. I made a funny face but you can draw flowers or insects or anything you like.

Tie string round the top of the bottle and put the lid back on  
So that you can tie the feeder to a tree in your garden or in the park  
Fill with left over kitchen scraps or bird seed if you have any. Watch and see what kind of birds come to eat.



You can use an old ready meal or take away tray to make a bird bath  
Get an adult to help make holes at each corner and tie a length of string in each.  
hang the bird bath on a tree branch and fill with water. The birds will enjoy bathing in it and drinking it.
