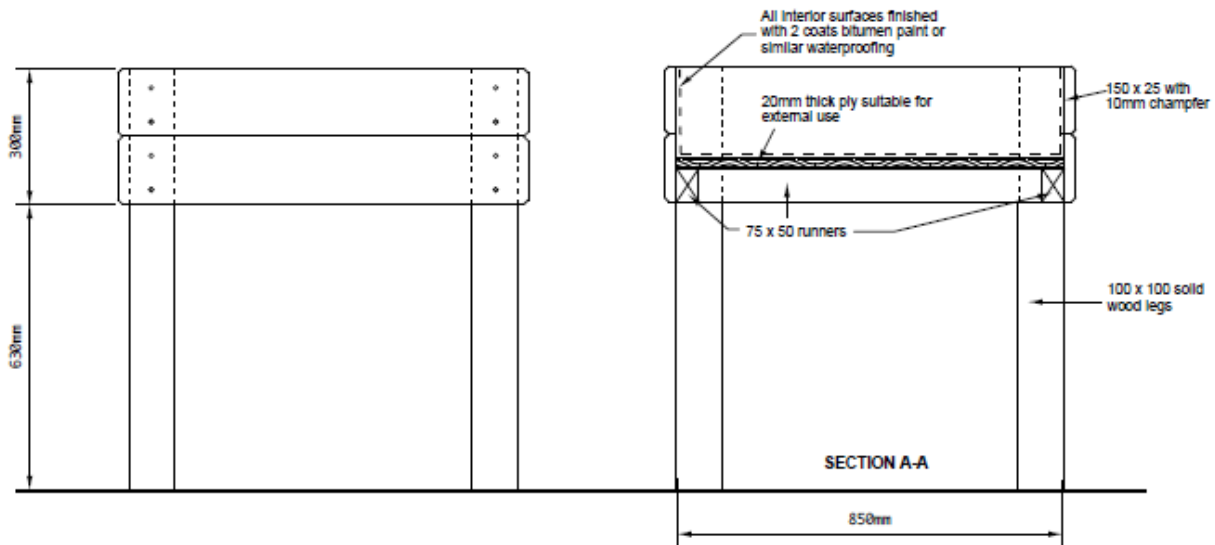




## Table top bed/planter



Above is a drawing of a table top planter which can accommodate seated and wheelchair gardening.

### Dimensions

For a table top bed to allow the gardener to sit face on to the soil surface, whilst legs and chair fit under, table top heights range between 63 - 75cm from the ground depending on the height of the chair to be accommodated and to allow for easy reaching over sides of the bed.

Depending on the strength of the table bed construction and the clearance required for chair and person, the soil bed can vary from 25cm - 35cm.

### Materials and finishes

- Use Pressure treated wood, suitable for external use
- Thick plywood (suitable for external use) for base of planter, drilled with drainage holes
- Use non-rusting screws and fixings (non-ferrous) suitable for outdoors
- waterproofing finish /lining on inside surfaces of bed
